In part I of the said rules, in rule 85, in the last sentence, after the words ‘Leave not due should be granted only’ the words “when no other leave with Allowances is available at credit of the officer and “shall be inserted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Rules 85, Part I, Kerala Service Rules as it stands at present does not prohibit grant of ‘leave not due’ when ‘other kinds of leave with allowances’ are available at the credit of an officer. The existing conditions for the grant of ‘leave not due’ are thus too liberal with the result that instead of limiting it to cases of emergency, it is resorted to as a matter of course. The intention is to restrict the grant of ‘leave not due’ only when other kinds of ‘leave with allowances due’ are not available. In order to make the position clear the above amendment is issued. It will have effect from the date of issue.
