Notwithstanding the repeated instructions issued in the past prohibiting the employment of lest grade Government servants for private or demonstic work of officers. Government regret that complaints are still being received that the practice of services of the last grade employees being made use of forpersonal and domestic purposes, particularly on occasions of feasts and ceremonies, still continues. This practice, a survival of the past is undignified, objectionable and unworthy. Government desire that this practice should stop. They expect scrupulous observance of all the properties by the Officers and would wish that they give no room whatsoever for such ugly complaints in future.
