An instance of failure on the part of an Institution to preserve the data and record sheets of the findings on which expert opinion was given by their staff has been brought to the notice of Government. This is a serious emission since he expert opinion which is unsupported by adequate data can be accepted for any authentic purpose. On considering the question Government order that whenever any expert opinion is furnished by any Government servant, the detailed ata and record sheets relating to the findings which form the basis of the opinion should be preserved for a minimum period of three years subject to the following conditions.

- (a) There a different period of retention is already approved by Government such period will continue to apply.
- (b) Where the data is recorded in a prescribed Register maintained continuously under prescribed Departmental orders, the Register will be kept in safe custogy by the appropriate authority.
- (c) Where the data and record sheets are prepared separately and not in a prescribed register maintained as mentioned in (b) above those should immediately be signed and submitted to the head of the office for safe custody as part of the records of the office.
