ORDER

According to Rule 102, Part I, Kerala Service Rules, maternity leave may be combined with leave of any other kind, but any leave applied for in continuation of the former will be granted only if the request is supported by a medical certificate. In the O.M read above Government of India have decided that a female Central Civil Government Servant may be allowed leave of any kind due including commuted leave, if she so desires, in continuation of maternity leave up to a maximum of 60 days without the production of Medical Certificate. Government have examined the question of extending the benefit to female Government Servants of the State and they are pleased to order that female State Government employees may be granted leave of any kind due, including commuted leave, if they so desire in continuation of maternity leave up to a maximum of 60 days without the production of medical certificate.

Formal amendments to Kerala Service Rule will be issued separately.
