ORDER

In the Government Order read above, orders were issued extending the principle of non-cadre promotion as obtaining for the teaching staff of Arts and Science Colleges to the teaching staff in the Technical Education Department and Medical Colleges also. Since Government have accepted the principle of Parity of Scales of pay and other conditions of service of the staff in Government Engineering Colleges/Polytechnics and the Private Engineering Colleges/Polytechnics it is hereby ordered that the benefit of non-cadre promotion, ordered in the Government Order read above, shall be extended to the teaching staff of Private Engineering Colleges and Polytechnics also on the same terms and conditions as are applicable in the case of teaching staff in the Technical Education Department.
