ORDER

In the Office Memorandum read above, the governments of India have ordered that no deduction should be made from the Death-cum-Retirement Gratuity as contribution towards family pension in respect of general government employees.

2. Government have considered the question of extending the benefit to the state government employees and are pleased to order that no deduction towards family pension will be made from the death-Cum-Retirement Gratuity of the state Government employees whose pensioner claims are payable from 1-10-1977.

3. Necessary amendment to the relevant rules in part III, Kerala Service Rules, will issue separately.
