ORDER

On receipt of representations from affected parties, the Minister for Forests and Harijan Welfare personally inspected the area alongwith officers of the Forest Department. It was found that by conceding the requests of the representatives the forest land that would be lost would be only 1.6 hectares which was in the possession of the 11 families and misery to these families. They were deprived of even moving space. In the circumstances Government order that the boundary will be fixed according to the original possession of these eleven families, giving them land and marking claims and survey stones accordingly.
