ORDER

In the G.O. read as first paper above, orders have been issued to the effect that the scheme National Physical Efficiency drive will be continued to be implemented in this State as a State Sector scheme during the Fourth Five Year Plan period. Sanction was also accorded for a total expenditure not exceeding %.7900/- for conducting the drive in 1966-67.

- 2. The Director of Public Instruction, in the liter read as second paper above, has submitted necessary proposals for the implementation of the scheme during 1967-68. Government after detailed consideration of these proposals are pleased to issue the following orders for the implementation of the scheme during 1967-68.
- 1. The date of drive will be fixed by the Director of Public Instruction in consultation with the State Liaison Officer.
- University College, Trivandrum will continue as Liaison Officer He is authorised to perform the necessary journeys in and outside the headquarters in connection with the drive. The Liason Officer shall proceed on such tours as and when necessary under intimation to the Principal, University College, Tivandrum. He will be eligible for T.A. and D.A. as per rules. Under rule 4 Part II, K.S.R. the Liaison Officer is permitted to claim mileage allowance for journeys between places connected by Railway provided the journeys are actually performed by Road.
- 3. The Lisison Officer is directed to contact all Heads of Departments, the University, The Director of Public Insustruction and their subordinate officers, and to select proper organisation and testing centres. For this year's drive he will select 26 organisers and not less than 50 testing

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centres. The organisers may be selected from Government Departments, Sport Associations, Posts and Telegraphs Department, Aluminium Industries F.A.C.T. etc. for conducting the drive.

- 4. The Liason Officer will be eligible for an honorarium %.100/- per Mensum for 12 months in connection with the implementation of the scheme. As the honorarium is paid for 12 months no additional remuneration will be paid to the officer for the running of the permanent testing centre under the scheme during 1967-68.
- 5. Sanction is also accorded to the appointment of the following temporary staff for the work.
- i. One Clerk-cun-Typist on a consolidated pay of Rs.100/- per menseum for 9 months.
- ii. One peon on a consolidated pay of %.74/- per mensem for a period of 9 months.
- 6 The Controller of Stationery is requested to supply a typewriter to the State Liaison Officer immediately on loan basis to be returned after the special work is over.
- 7. The Liaison Officer is authorised to make payment of \$5.50 each to 25 organisers as advance for purchasing equipments for conducting the drive.
- 8. The Director of Public Relations is requested to rgive wide publicity to the scheme in consultation with the State Liason Officer and to arrange to publish matters that will be supplied by the Liaison Officer on connection with the drive so as to make the scheme popular.
- Officers are requested to issue instructions to their subordinates to extend their whole hearted cooperation by giving publicity to the scheme and also by participating in the physical efficiency. Test. The Kerala Sports Council, also is requested to extend their full cooperation to the State Liaison Officer in making the drive a success.
- tests are conducted are permitted to spend an amount not exceeding 18.100 (Rupees one hundred only) out of the comes Fund subject to availability to conduct the drive if such schools are chosen as testing centres.

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11. The Government servants who are called upon to participate in the physical efficiency Test will be given special casual leave:

3. Sanction is accorded for incurring a total expenditure not exceeding &. 8416/- (Rupees eight thousand four hundred and sixteen only) for conducting the drive in 1967-68. The exenditure in this regard will be debited to "28 Education X(F) General (1) Miscellaueous - (33) Schemes under the Five Year Plan (xviii) Physical Education.". The Director of Public Instruction is authorised to draw the entire amount and advance to the Liaison officer as and when a request in this behalf is made by him.

4. The break-up of the approved expenditure regarding the scheme is appended to this order.
