Sub:- Inspection Report on the accounts of the Office of the C.F.Chalakudy.
Ref:- Your letter No.0A7-10-142/66-67/438 dated 27-8-66.

It is stated by the Chief Conservator of Forests that sale value in certain cases was less than seigniorage and working charges. The description vested in the Officers to judge whether a log will fetch approximately seigniorage plus working charges or not should be exercised carefully. Yet in practice, it is not always possible to judge whether a log marginal quality or size will fetch value above seigniorage plus working charges.

However strict instructions have been issued to the Divisional Forest Officers to instruct all Range Officers not to register logs that are not likely to fetch value above seigniorage plus working charges in Depots.
