ORDER

in the auction ale notice in respect of residual tree growth in sale coupe system there is provision for granting extension of in sale coupe system there is provision for granting extension of time by the departmental officers. But in many cases, extension of time beyond the period is allowed by the departmental officers, subject to ratification by overnment. Directions were issued by Government to the Chief Conservator of Forests were issued by Government to the Chief Conservator of Forests to evolve new guidelines to curb these tendencies. The Chief Conservator of Forests in his letter read above . has brought to the notice of Government that there are cases where sanctions were accorded in anticipation of Government sanctions since the departmental officers are not of Government sanction, since the departmental officers are not delegated with powers to cope up with the situation, for example for the remittance of balance value, security, deposit and execution of agreement of sale coupes for which the Chief Conservator of Forests is not empowered to grant any extension. The Chief Conservator of Forests has therefore, requested Government to delegate him with the following powers:-

- a) In case the bidder failed to remit the balance1/3 value, Sales Tax and security within the extension period of 30 days granted by the Conservator of Forests, the Chief Conservator of Forests may at his discretion grant further extension up to 30 days with penal interest at 30% per annum provided the above period falls within the contract period.
- In case the bidder failed to remit the balance 2/3 value within the extension period of 30 days granted by the Conservator of Forests at 24% interest the Chief Conservator of Forests may at his direction grant further extension of 30 days with penal interest at 30% per annum provided the above period falls within the contract period.
- Government have examined the matter in detail and they are pleased to delegate the following powers to the Chief Conservator of Forests with regard to extension of period for remittance of value for the forest produce (residual tree growth) auctioned.
- i) In case the bidder failed to remit the balance 1/3 value, Sales Tax and security within the extension period of 30 days a granted by the Conservator of Forests, the ChiefConservator of Forests may at listing a long grant of their extension up to 50 days with penal interest at 30% per annum provided the above period falls within the contract period.

ii) In case the bidder failed to remit the balance 2/3 value within the extension period of 30 days granted by the Conservator of Forests at 24% interest the Chief Conservator of Forests may at his discretion grant further extension upto 30 days with penal interest at 30% per annum provided the above period falls within the contract period.
