

Copy of G.O. MS. 102/7^B/AD dated 30.3.197^B Agriculture (Forest General) Department, Trivandrum. (135) 720/ (447)

Forest land - Trichur Division - Leasing of 3.62 hectares of forest land in Patticad South Beat, Peechi Range, Paravattanimala Reserve to the Public Health Engineering Department for the Trichur Water Supply Augmentation Scheme - sanctioned. 9577

Read:- 1. G.O. MS. 80/75/AD/ dated 13.3.1975.
2. Letter No: BHR.22771/77/dated 29.10.77 of the Chief Engineer, Public Health Engineering Department.
3. Letter No: P6-60406/77 dated 17/20.12.77 of the CCF, Tm.

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In the Government order read above sanction was accorded for the disreservation and transfer of 25 cents of Forest land just below the filter plant of head works at Peechi in Trichur Division to Revenue Department for allotment to the Public Health Engineering Department for constructing a ground level tank for the Trichur water supply scheme.

2. The Chief Engineer, Public Health Engineering Department Trivandrum in his letter read as 2nd paper above has requested the Government to hand over 3.62 ha. of forest land for the construction of Adl. treatment plant for the Trichur water supply Augmentation Scheme.

3. The Chief Conservator of Forests, Trivandrum in his letter read as 3rd paper above reported to Government that the 3.62 ha. of forest land including the 25 cents of land already ordered to be allotted to the public Health Engineering Department may be leased out to that Department cancelling the orders contained in G.O. 1st read above.

4. In the circumstances stated above, the orders issued in G.O. MS. 80/75/AD are cancelled.

5. Sanction is accorded to lease out 3.62 ha. of forest land at Peechi in Pananchery village, Paravattanimala Reserve Patticad South Beat, Peechi Range, Trichur Division to Public Health Engineering Department for the construction of Additional treatment plant of Trichur Water Supply Augmentation Scheme on the following terms and conditions.

- i. The period of lease will be 5 years in the First instance.
- ii. The lease rent will be Rs. 250/- per hectares per annum.
- iii. The tree growth in the area will be enumerated and en-

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trusted to the Public Health Engineering Department for safe custody.

iv. The trees which are absolutely necessary to be felled and removed will be extracted departmentally by the Forest Department limiting the expenditure to the sanctioned Schedule rates.

v. No tree growth will be felled without the permission of the Forest Department. The Public Health Engineering Department will be responsible for the damages caused to the tree growth. The salvage value of trees to be felled will be given to the Forest Department by the Public Health Engineering Department. The felled trees will be sold in auction by the Forest Department and the cost will be adjusted as in the case of the trees on the area leased to the Kerala State Electricity Board.

6. The Chief Conservator of Forests will take further action in the matter.
