PROCEEDINGS OF THE CHIEF CONSERVATOR OF FORESTS, TRIVANDRUM.

Sub:- Grazing of Private elephants in Reserve Forests  
Read:- Report No. A6-5348/67 dated 13-7-1967.  
ORDER ON G4(K. Dis.) 26248/67/7/13-11-67.

The Conservator of Forests, Kozhikode in his letter cited has suggested that allowing to graze private elephants in Reserve Forests is not advisable except that of elephants engaged in Government work by Forest Contractors. The Conservators, Chalakudy, and Quilon have also endorsed this view. Therefore it is ordered that grazing of private elephants in Reserve Forests will not be allowed hereafter but that elephants engaged for work in coupes of Government Forests may be allowed to graze in the forests after collecting the fees, prescribed therefor.
