The following amendment is issued to the Manual of Office Procedure namely:—

In the said Manual, after paragraph 166 and the entries the eunder the following shall be added as paragraph 167.

"167 Peons. —Peons will be under the immediate control of the section heads who are responsible for the transaction of work in the sections and officers. They are expected to do the duties allotted to them by section heads and clerks and also by the officers to whom they are attached. The ministerial staff should not use peons for their private work."
