ORDER

In the G.O. read Government have ordered among other things that Government shall suo motu sanction surrender of Earned Leave at the credit of an officer at the time of his retirements or death while in service Government hereby clarify that no application from the retiring/retired officer is necessary for sanctioning surrender of the entire Earned Leave at his credit as on the date of retirement in terms of the above G.O.. In the case of Gazetted Officers a formal sanction will be issued by the authority competent to sanction leave to the officer concerned and the Accountant General requested to authorize payment of surrender leave salary after due verification if the amount of Earned Leave at his credit. In the case of non-Gazetted Officers the authority competent to sanction leave to the officer concerned will issue the sanction permitting him to surrender the entire Earned Leave at his credit after due verification and the Drawing and Disbursing Officer will draw and disburse the surrender leave salary. What is meant by the term 'Government' used in the above G.O is only the concerned leave sanctioning authority.
