ORDER

In the Government Order read as first paper above, Government issued orders allowing the benefit of higher grade, with effect from 1-7-1979, to all non gazetted officers who remain in the entry grade without promotion in the normal course, on completion of 13 years of service in the entry grade. Government have issued certain instruction for the implementation of the above Government Order in the G.O. cited second.

- 2. Now in the State Service, the Peons have two grades viaz., entry grade Rs. 280-400 and higher grade on Rs. 290-425 on ration of 1;9 between the higher grade and lower grade. Besides those who have completed 13 years of service in the entry grade can get the scale of pay of Rs.290-425 as the higher grade. Higher grade peons on Rs. 290-425 on completion of 13 years of qualifying service can get grade promotion in the scale of Rs. 300-450.
- 3. In the memorandum cited third, the President, Kerala Secretariat Last Grade Officer's Association has requested to allow them three grades on the basis of total service.
- 4. Government after having examined the question in detail are pleased to order as a very special case, not to be quoted as a precedent that a further higher grade will be allowed in the scale of pay of Rs. 330-515 to the last grade employees who have completed 25 years of qualifying service.
- 5. These orders will have effect from 30-6-1963.
