PUBLIC SERVICES-NON GAZETTED OFFICER WOTHOUT ADEQUATE PROMOTIONAL AVENUES – BENEFIT OF HIGHER GRADE SANCTIONED- POST OF CLEANER IN ALL DEPARTMENTS- HIGHER GRADE FIXED ORDERS ISSUED

ORDER

In the G.O. read as first paper above all the heads of departments were instructed to furnish to Government, the detail of all entry posts/isolated post in their departments so as to enable Government to fix suitable higher grade in all such cases.

- 2. The Additional Secretary (Excise) Board of Revenue in his letter 2nd cited has pointed out the case of a Cleaner (Rs. 280-400) attached to the Excise Circle Office, Neyyattinkara, who has completed 13 years service in that post for purpose of fixing suitable higher grade. It has been stated that he is unqualified to be promoted as driver.
- 3. Government have examined the case in detail. As the post of Driver Grade II requires additional qualification (Std. VII or equivalent and valid driving licence), it cannot be considered as the normal promotion post for Cleaner, and accordingly the scale of pay of Driver Grade II (Rs.310-490) cannot be assigned as the higher grade for the post of Cleaner. In the circumstances Government are pleased to order that the higher grade for the post of Cleaner on Rs. 280-400 in all departments shall be fixed as indicated below so that those who remain in the entry grade may get the benefit grade promotion in terms of the G.O. read above:-
