ORDER

At present there is no provision in the Kerala Service Rules as to how pay of an officer should be regulated from to time in cases where a series of penalties of withholding of increment are imposed. Governments have examined the question and are pleased to issue the following as Ruling under Rule 31, Part I, Kerala Service Rules.

Ruling No. 54/84

"In cases where penalties of withholding of increments are imposed on an officer, one after another, in separate disciplinary cases, the effect of the first order withholding increment will continue for the period specified in that order Thereafter, the pay will be fixed by granting the increments which would have been admissible, but for the imposition of penalty and only then will the second order withholding increment be implemented, which will continue to be in force for the period specified therein, and so on".
