ORDER

In the G.O. read Government have ordered that employees appointed on provisional basis, contract basis those appointed on fixed monthly honorarium against regular sanctioned posts and are eligible to surrender earned leave as per rules will be permitted to encash the entire earned leave to their credit as on the date of termination of appointment, irrespective of whether 12 months have elapsed after the previous

surrender, if any or not.

2. Now the Accountant General has raised a point whether re-employed

pensioners are eligible for the benefit sanctioned in the above G.O.

3. Re-employed pensioners stand on the same footing as the categories of

employees mentioned in para 2 of the G.O. read. Government are, therefore, pleased to

extend the benefit of the G.O. read to re-employed pensioners also.

4. This order will taken effect from 20-4-1985.
