NOTIFICATION

S.R.O No. 45/86. In exercise of the powers conferred by sub section (1) of section 2 of the Public Services Act, 1969 (19 of 1968) read with section 3 thereof, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following rules further to amend the Kerala Service Rules, namely:---

RULES C.S. No.441/85

- 1. Short title and commencement:-
 - (i) These rules may be called the Kerala Service (Amendment) Rules, 1985.
 - (ii) They shall be deemed to have come info force with effect from the 9th day of May, 1984.
- 2. Amendment of Rules:- In Part I of the Kerala Service Rules in Appendix VII, under the heading "Section II--- Special Casual Leave", after rule 16, the following rule shall be inserted namely:-
- 16A. All physically handicapped employees eligible to claim conveyance allowance shall be eligible for special casual leave for a maximum period of 15 days in a

calendar year for treatment of illness connected with the physically handicapped of the employee concerned in Hospital or at residence on production of medical certificate to that effect from the authorized Medical Officers attending of them.

Explanatory

(This does not form part of the amendment but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

According to the existing rules the benefit of special casual leave is admissible to disabled employees only for attending Artificial Limp Centre for treatment and for stay in Hospital for replacement/treatment of artificial limbs. The objective for this amendment is to extend the benefit of Special Casual Leave to all types of physically handicapped employees who are eligible for conveyance allowance for their treatment in hospital/at residence.
