In the G.O read as paper above , it has been clarified that the above orders are in relaxation to Article 325 and Article 5 (b) T.S.R and that it would apply to persons governed by C.S.R also.

Now the Comptroller in his latter cited has requested to clarify whether the benefit of the G.O would accrue from 1-11-56 or from the date of the orders viz.30-7-59 only.

After careful consideration of the question Government are pleased to order that the orders in the G."O cited as first paper above will be even effect from 1-11-1956. Accordingly the benefits of revised pension will accrue from 1-11-1956.
