## O R D E R

In the G.O. read as first paper above, orders were issued prescribing certain terms and conditions for the final withdrawal of Provident Fund money for the purchase of house-sites by officers who have completed twenty-five years of service or who for construction of houses thereon. It was, inter alia, ordered that the actual withdrawal from the Fund should be made only on receipt of an authorization from the Comptroller, the installments after the first being authorised by the sanctioning authority after verification regarding the progress of construction of the house.

2. The Comptroller has since raised a doubt as to whether the drawal of the second and subsequent installments can be made without an authorization from him.

3. Government have considered the above point and are pleased to clarify that the drawal of the second and the subsequent installments referred to in para  $3^{\circ}$  of the aforesaid G.O. also require an authorisation from the Comptroller, as laid down in para 1 (d) of the G.O.

4. Necessary amendments to Rule III ( c) issued under G.O. No.(P) 503/59 dated 24-9-1939 will be issued in due course.
