1. Amendment to G.P.F.(Cochin)Rules

Insert the following as Note (3) under rule 12

Note 3- If an advance has been granted to a subscriber and drawn by him and the advance is subsequently disallowed before repayment is completed, the whole or balance of the amount withdrawn, shall with interest at the rate provided in rule10, forthwith be repaid by the subscriber to the Fund, or in default, be ordered by the Accounts officer to be recovered by deduction from the emoluments of the subscriber by instalments or otherwise, as Government may direct:

Provided that Muhammadan subscribers whose deposits in the Fund carry no interest shall not be required to pay any interest. ."

II. Introduce the following as a note below rule 11 in Appendix 37 of Travancore Financial and Accountant Code Vol.11.
