### **ORDER**

In the G.O read as first paper above it was ordered, among there things, that in respect of the allotted officers from madras who opted to be governed by the kerala service rules instead of madras contributory provident fund pension insurance rules in the matter of retirement benefits and who have already drawn temporary advances from their C.P.P.F.Accounts, recoveries of the advances would be made until the recoupment of the entire amount of advances.

- 2. It is brought to the notice of government that as per the G O referred to above advances drawn by subscribers who have opted to kerala service rules and taken out policies in the state life insurance (Official Branch) are also being recovered.
- 3. Government now consider that in the case of those who have taken out policies in the state life insurance (Official branch)in lieu of provident fund, recovery of temporary advances is not necessary and they are pleased to order accordingly.
