ORDER

Rule 14 of the General Provident Fund (Madras) Rules, Rule 12 of the General Provident Fund (Cochin) Rules and Rule 11 of the State Provident Fund (Travancore) Rules as amended from time to time, provide for the grant of temporary advances to the subscribers from the amounts standing to their credit in the Funds. These Rules also specify the objects for which such temporary advances can be granted.

- 2. In cases where the Government are satisfied that a temporary advance applied for by a subscriber is really necessary for purpose other than those provided for in the rules, they have to relax the rules to sanction the advance as there is no provision in the rules enebling them to deal with such and equitable manner.
- 3. Government are, therefore, pleased to order that an enebling provision on the following lines will be introduced in the State Provident Fund (Travancore) General Provident Fund (Cochin) and the General Provident Fund (Madras) Rules:

The Government may at their discretion in special circumstances, sanction a temporary advance if they are satisfied that the subscriber concerned requires the advance for a purpose other than those provided for in the rules".

- 4. This order will come in to force immediately.
- 5. Suitable Amendments to the relevant rules will be issued for due course.
